

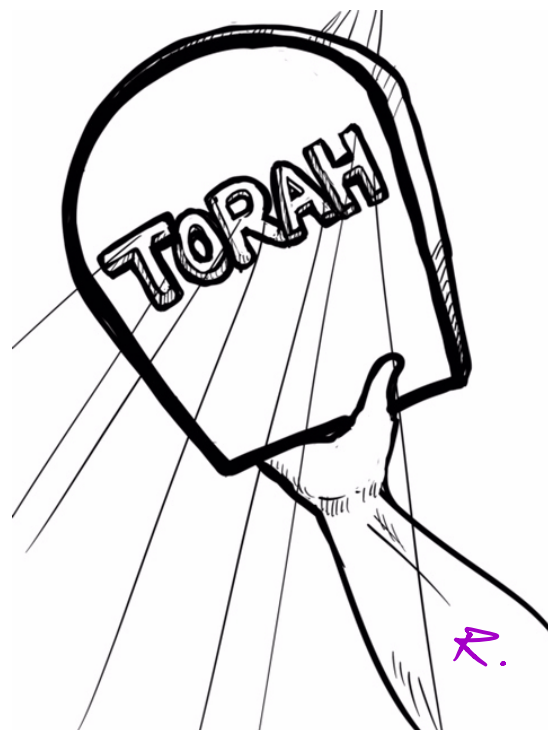

(*asuph'suph*)

*Craving what we do not have
makes us despise what we do have.*

The Taste of *Manna*

- “...*like coriander seed*”

כִּזְרַע גֹּד
(*ciz'ra gad*)

Or...

“*seed of good fortune*”

- “...*its appearance like the appearance of **b'dolach***”

Genesis 2:11-12

The name of the first [river] is Pishon. It flows around the whole land of Havilah, where there is gold. The gold of that land is good. The ***b'dolach*** and the *shoham* stone is there.

- “...its **taste** was like the **taste** of oil cakes.”

Psalms 34:1 A Psalm of David when he disguised his sanity before Abimelech, who drove him away and he departed: I will bless Adonai at all times. His praise shall continually be in my mouth. [1 Samuel 21:13]

1 Samuel 25:32-33 Then David said to Abigail, “Blessed be Adonai God of Israel, who sent you this day to meet me, and blessed be your discernment, and blessed be you, who have kept me this day from bloodshed and from avenging myself by my own hand.”

Proverbs 31:18 She senses that her gain is good. Her lamp does not go out at night.
