Exodus 23:14-16

“Three times a year you shall celebrate a **feast** [לֶחַם, *chag*] to Me. You shall observe the **Feast of Unleavened Bread**. For seven days you are to eat unleavened bread, as I commanded you, at the appointed time in the month *Aviv*, for in it you came out of Egypt. And none shall appear before Me empty-handed. Also *you shall observe* the **Feast of the Harvest** of the first fruits of your labors *from* what you sow in the field, also the **Feast of the Ingathering** [*Sukkot*] at the end of the year when you gather in *the fruit of* your labors from the field.”

Leviticus 23:22

When you reap the harvest of your land, moreover, you shall not reap to the very corners of your field nor gather the gleaning of your harvest. You are to leave them for the poor and the sojourner. I am Adonai your God.

Indeed all Israel has transgressed Your Torah and turned aside, not obeying Your voice; **so the curse has been poured out on us, along with the oath which is written in the Torah of Moses the servant of God**, for we have sinned against Him.”
