

Eliezer (אליעזר) = "My God Helps"

- Controlled all the household (1-2)
- Sent by the Father
- Sought a bride for the Son (4)
- Bride to come willingly (8)
- Has all the "good" of the Master (10)
- Returned to the city of the "slayer / piercer" (10)
 - Nachor (נחור) = "slayer / piercer"
- ...in the land of "rebellion" (10)
 - Aram (מרא) reversed is (ארם) "rebellion"
- Does not follow human logic (14)
- Looks for one with the heart of Abraham (14)
- He gave gifts (22)
- No respecter of persons (23)
- Must be invited in (31)
- Everything belongs to the Son (36)
- Testifies of the Father and the Son (33-49)
- Gave gifts, garments, and fruits (53-54)

- Does not accept delay (56)
- Leads the bride home (61)
- Reveals the Son to the Bride (64-65)
 - 1st Abraham sends his **servant** to procure a bride for his son.
 - **2**nd Isaac sends his **son** to procure a bride for himself.

Genesis 28:1-5

So Isaac called Jacob and blessed him and charged him, and said to him, "You shall not take a wife from the daughters of Canaan. Arise, go to Paddan-aram, to the house of Bethuel your mother's father; and from there take to yourself a wife from the daughters of Laban your mother's brother. May God Almighty bless you and make you fruitful and multiply you, that you may become a company of peoples. May He also give you the blessing of Abraham, to you and to your descendants with you, that you may possess the land of your sojournings, which God gave to Abraham." Then

- **2**nd The Father sends **His Son** to win a bride for Himself.
