## Genesis 18:17-19

Adonai said, "Shall I hide from Abraham what I am about to do, since Abraham will surely become a great and mighty nation, and in him all the nations of the earth will be blessed? For I have chosen him, so that he may command his children and his household after him to keep the way of Adonai by doing righteousness and justice, so that Adonai may bring upon Abraham what He has spoken about him."

## The Sins of Sodom:

Isaiah 3:9-12

The expression of their faces bears witness against them, and they display their sin like Sodom. They do not *even* conceal *it*. Woe to them! For they have brought evil on themselves. Say to the righteous that *it will go* well *with them*, for they will eat the fruit of their actions. Woe to the wicked! *It will go* badly *with him* for what he deserves will be done to him O My people! Their oppressors are children, and women rule over them. O My people! Those who guide you lead *you* astray and confuse the direction of your paths.



## Jeremiah 23:14

Also among the prophets of Jerusalem I have seen a horrible thing: the committing of adultery and walking in falsehood; and they strengthen the hands of evildoers so that no one has turned back from his wickedness. All of them have become to Me like Sodom, and her inhabitants like Gomorrah.




## **Ezekiel 16:49**

**Abomination!** 



- Chooses the "non-option" (13:8-11)
- Does not learn from his mistakes (ch.14)
- Ashamed of his circumstances (19:1-3)
- Is a "joke" to his family (19:14)
- Hesitant to obey (19:6)
- Everything seems "too hard" (19:17-20)
- Brings destruction to his wife (19:26)
- Children develop a warped view (19:31-38)
- Fades into oblivion
- But still called "righteous" (2 Peter 2:7-8)
