Deuteronomy 5:29 [32]


You shall not turn aside to the **right** or to the **left**.

So then, the Torah is holy, and the commandment is holy and righteous and good... For we know that the Torah is spiritual, but I am of flesh...




***“...for it is your wisdom and discernment


Deuteronomy 5:16
