Genesis 24

Eliezer (אֱלִיעֶזֶר) = “My God Helps”

John 15:26

“When the helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, that is the spirit of truth that proceeds from the Father, he will testify about Me.”

- Controlled all the household (1-2)
- Sent by the Father
- Sought a bride for the Son (4)
- The Son not to return with Eliezer (5-8)
- Bride to come willingly (8)
- Has all the “good” of the Master (10)
- Returned to the city of the “*slayer / piercer*” (10)
 - *Nachor* (נַחֹר) = “*slayer / piercer*”
- ...in the land of “*rebellion*” (10)
 - *Aram* (אַרַם) reversed is (מַרְא) “*rebellion*”
- Does not follow human logic (12-14)
- Looks for one with the heart of Abraham (14)
- He gave gifts (22)

קָרוֹן (f.)
 Πνευμα (n.)

תָּסֵד ○ Nose ring (= redemption) 1 *beka* (בִּקְעָה)
 אֶתֶת ○ Bracelets (= Torah) 5 + 5 = 10 *shekels*

- No respecter of persons (23)
- Must be invited in (31)
- *Everything belongs to the Son* (36)

John 16:15

*“All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore, I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose **it to you.**”*

- Makes a testimony (33-49)
- Understanding comes last (48-49)
- Gave gifts, garments, and fruits (53-54)
- Does not accept delay (56)
- Leads the bride home (61)
 - The Son “lives” and “sees” [*Beer-lacha-roï*] (62)
- Reveals the Son to the Bride (64-65)
 - The Bride covers herself (65 + Revelation 19:7-8)
- She enters Sarah’s tent (67)

לבן (Laban) = "White"
לבל (Nabal) = "Fool"

Q: What does chapter 23 have to do with chapter 24?

Ruth 4:5

Then Boaz said, “On the day you buy **the field** from the hand of Naomi, you must also acquire **Ruth the Moabitess**, the widow of the deceased, in order to raise up the name of the deceased on his inheritance.”

Romans 8:19-23

For the anxious longing of **the creation** waits eagerly for the revealing of **the sons of God**. (For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself also will be set free from its slavery to corruption into the freedom of the glory of the children of God.) For we know that the whole creation groans and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now.
