THE SUM OF ALL FEARS

- They cried out to the LORD.
 - o They should have stopped here!
- They said to Moses, 'Were there no graves in Egypt...
 - They turn their attack against something/someone tangible.
 - Note the mocking tone.
- ...that you took us...
 - God is left completely out of the picture.
- ...to die...
 - All fear is fear of death in some form.
- ...in the wilderness?
 - Their fear of death would ultimately cause them to die in the wilderness!
- What is this...
 - Had they practiced self-control they would have known what "this" is.
 - Fear makes us forgetful
- ...that you have done to us to take us out of Egypt?
 - Fear causes us to crave security in any form.

- O Thus fear makes us slaves. (Heb.2:15)
- Is this not the statement that we made to you 'Let us be and we will serve Egypt?'
 - Again, fear makes us slaves.
 - o Fear makes us regress.
 - Fear makes us weak.
- It is better to serve Egypt than to die in the wilderness.
 - Fear limits our vision we only see two outcomes.
 - Fear makes us stupid.

The Voice of FEAR:

- Insecurity feels painful
- Pain feels like death
- Fear of death makes us slaves

The Voice of FAITH:

- All pain IS birth pain
- Birth IS new life
- Life IS strength and freedom

Fear is illegal for the Believer!
