

Keeping children's attention can be a challenge....especially when it comes to Bible time! Rosella Groves shares how she is making it work in her home and how she uses imagination and art to "draw" her kids into the stories and teachings of Scripture.

In this episode, a busy mom shows and tells how an appetite for and knowledge of God's word has been sown into her children's hearts through family Bible time.

THIS WEEK

Choose a story from Scripture and get creative. Try acting out the scene and involving your kids. Dress the parts (to some degree) if you can and have different family members play a role. It's best to read the story first, then act it out, then talk about it afterwards.

For older kids, help them engage in the EMOTION of the story. Ask, "How do you think x-character felt? When have you ever felt that way in your life? What did x-character do? What did you do?"

Also, engage older kids by asking them to describe their vision of the scene. The paralytic through the roof for example. "I think there was dust and straw everywhere. Dust was all over the food, the table, the guests, and even in Yeshua's hair and on his face." Or "I think it was a warm day that day, the room was only lamp lit until the hole was made, and then a sunbeam shot through the roof."
