

Use the Tabernacle Furnishings for Meditating on Scripture

- Altar—Lay down your own initiative, self-effort and strength. Confess your sins and repent.
- Laver—Looking into the Biblical texts, place yourself in the shoes of the original hearers and listen as if the words were directly spoken to you.
- Shewbread—Let your will be ground fine before God and submit to the things you've learned from today's text so you may walk in fellowship with Messiah and His people.
- Lampstand—Ask God to enlighten your understanding of the verses you're pondering. Take notes on specific insights He may bring to you.
- Incense—In prayer and praise, give thanks to God for what He has and is revealing to you in today's passage.
- Ark- Still yourself and quietly, with an open mind quiet before God, wait for 30-60 seconds to receive any instruction, exhortation, rebuke, or encouragement He may have for you.

In all things, keep in mind that the Spirit of God will only reveal or instruct that which is in keeping with the plainly revealed truths of Scripture. Don't expect a new revelation, but instead, a revelation that is new (or renewed) **to you.**
