#2: Fellowship

Discussion Questions:

1. In Genesis 2:24 we see described, succinctly, the “perfect fellowship—sharing the joys and burdens of life.” Using this as a measure of degrees of fellowship, how much would you say you are “in fellowship” with each of your family members, friends, fellow disciples, neighbors, etc.?
2. If koinonia (“fellowship”) can be understood as “shared participation” in a given community, how do we practice it? What material or practical ways can we be “doing koinonia” with each other? What immaterial or spiritual ways?
3. How are we in fellowship with Adonai?
4. Oneg—or any potluck, really—is a great example of the importance of fellowship. We are all invited to participate, and we do so by sharing. What there is to eat is only what we all bring. What do you bring? What do you hope others bring? Do you share joyfully or is it a burden? Do you come hungry, or do you eat a little beforehand (or plan to go out to eat afterwards)?
