Discussion Questions:

- 1. What did Paul do for a living? And how might his vocation been used by God to work His will in the world? How might something you are skilled at or are passionate about in the physical realm find its equivalent in the spiritual realm? (Example: fishers of fish become fishers of people.)
- 2. Why did Paul shake out his cloak? Where ddi he establish the Corinthian place of assembly? What may have changed for the Corinthian believers when thy moved from the synagogue to the house-assembly of Titius Justus?
- 3. Why did the synagogue at Corinth need a new leader? How did Sosthenes and the Corinthian synagogue hope to eliminate their next door competition? From where do we derive the idea that Sosthenes became a believer, and what part might Paul have played?
- 4. What vow is associated with Paul's haircut at Cenchrea? What are the three possible reasons for the haircut?
- 5. Why did Paul tell the Galatians and the Corinthins to set aside the money on the first day of the week? When does the first day of the week begin? At this point did the early believers observe the first day of the week as their day of assembly and worship?
