"The Arrest of the Apostles"

Discussion Questions:

1. What does it mean to lay something at someone's feet? Reflect on aspects of your life that you have laid at the feet of Yeshua, of Adonai, of your elders, of your spouse or parents, of friends or colleagues. In each of those cases, are you right to come under their authority? Why or why not?
2. What was the sin of Ananias and Sapphira? Why must that have been dealt with so harshly?
3. Gamaliel, the wise Pharisee, is a fascinating character. If we understand that a Pharisee is, in simple terms, someone who (a) believed in the coming of Messiah, (b) believed in the resurrection, (c) taught in the synagogues, and (d) was a proponent of observances of the Law, who else in the Apostolic writings would qualify? How does that change your view of the Pharisees?
4. Who/what do you fear? In light of the reality that we are called by God to be His sent ones in the world, why would we fear anything but Him? And what does repentance from those unworthy fears look like?
