- 3. Read Gal. 1:11-24. What does this tell you about the unique way in which Paul came to believe in Yeshua?
- 4. The message of the Gospel that Paul would eventually proclaim, wasn't exactly the same message of the Gospel that the rest of the apostolic community proclaimed. How was it different?
