## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. What are all the reasons you can think of that Roman-era Gentiles (i.e. non-believers) would have been attracted to the God of the Bible and His people and ways, thus becoming "God-fearers"? Why might non-believers of the present day be attracted to the God of the Bible and His people and ways?
- 2. How have you heard Acts 10 interpreted as meaning that God repealed the laws prohibiting the eating of unclean animals? How does that miss the point?
- 3. At what points did Peter (a) understand the vision, and (b) understand why he was sent to Cornelius' house?
- 4. Philip, a Greek-speaking apostle, was already in Caesarea. Why was it to be Peter that came to Cornelius and not Philip?
- 5. This is the third outpouring of the Holy Spirit in Acts that corresponds with Yeshua's prediction in Acts. 1:8. Where are the previous two?
