Discussion Questions:

1. What are all the reasons you can think of that Roman-era Gentiles (i.e. non-believers) would have been attracted to the God of the Bible and His people and ways, thus becoming "God-fearers"? Why might non-believers of the present day be attracted to the God of the Bible and His people and ways?
2. How have you heard Acts 10 interpreted as meaning that God repealed the laws prohibiting the eating of unclean animals? How does that miss the point?
3. At what points did Peter (a) understand the vision, and (b) understand why he was sent to Cornelius' house?
4. Philip, a Greek-speaking apostle, was already in Caesarea. Why was it to be Peter that came to Cornelius and not Philip?
5. This is the third outpouring of the Holy Spirit in Acts that corresponds with Yeshua's prediction in Acts. 1:8. Where are the previous two?
