## #2 - "Fellowship"

# άλλήλων

(allélón - "one another")

The phrase "one another" is derived from the Greek word *allélón* which means "one another, each other; mutually, reciprocally." It occurs 100 times in the *B'rit Chadashah*. Approximately 59 of those occurrences are specific commands teaching us how (and how not) to relate to one another. Obedience to those commands is imperative. It forms the basis for all true Messianic communities, and has a direct impact on our witness to the world (John 13:35). In addition to *allélón*, the Bible uses other words and phrases to instruct us how to relate to others. With that in mind, the following list is not exhaustive, and primarily focuses on the use of *allélón*.

### **POSITIVE COMMANDS:**

Love one another (John 13:34)

Be devoted to one another (Rom. 12:10)

Honor one another above yourselves (Rom. 12:10)

Live in harmony with one another (Romans 12:16)

Build up one another (Rom. 14:19; 1 Thes. 5:11)

Be likeminded towards one another (Rom. 15:5)

Accept one another (Rom. 15:7)

Admonish one another (Rom. 15:14; Col. 3:16)

**Greet** one another (Rom. 16:16)

Care for one another (1 Cor. 12:25)

Serve one another (Gal. 5:13)

Bear one another's burdens (Gal. 6:2)

Forgive one another (Eph. 4:2, 32; Col. 3:13)

Be patient with one another (Eph. 4:2; Col. 3:13)

Speak the truth in love (Eph. 4:15, 25)

Be kind and compassionate to one another (Eph. 4:32)

Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs (Eph. 5:19)

Submit to one another (Eph. 5:21, 1 Pet. 5:5)

Consider others better than yourselves (Phil. 2:3)

Look to the interests of one another (Phil. 2:4)

Bear with one another (Col. 3:13)

Teach one another (Col. 3:16)

Comfort one another (1 Thes. 4:18)

Encourage one another (1 Thes. 5:11)

Exhort one another (Heb. 3:13)

Stir up one another to love and good works (Heb. 10:24)

Show hospitality to one another (1 Pet. 4:9)

Employ the gifts that God has given us for the benefit of one another (1 Pet. 4:10)

Clothe yourselves with humility towards one another (1 Pet. 5:5)

Pray for one another (Jam. 5:16)

Confess your faults to one another (Jam. 5:16)

#### **NEGATIVE COMMANDS** (how not to treat one another):

Do not lie to one another (Col. 3:9)

Stop passing judgment on one another (Rom. 14:13)

If you keep on biting and devouring one another...you'll be destroyed by one another (Gal. 5:15)

Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other (Gal. 5:26)

**Do not slander** one another (Jam. 4:11)

Don't grumble against each other (Jam. 5:9)

We do all this because we are in a real sense "**members of** one another" (Romans 12:5; Ephesians 4:25).
