YEHOSHUA

Chapters 15-17

& Vayikra

In these chapters we get underway in the portioning out of the land of Canaan, which is west of the Jordan. From here through the end of chapter 19 we read the precise descriptions of the boundaries of the tribal lands.

Joshua Discussion Questions:

- 1. What are some of the boundaries God has set for your life that you have a hard time staying on the right side of?
- 2. What are some boundaries you have placed in your life to help you be set apart?
- 3. Discuss what you think it means to "abide in" Yeshua. (See the definitions of the Hebrew words "amad" (מָמֵט; Strongs H5975) and "qum" (קוֹם; Strongs H6965) from the Septuagint.)

Vayikra Discussion Questions:

- 4. "Vayikra" means "and He called." How does God "call out" to us, and we to Him, through such laws as those related to sacrifices, and "leprosy," and clean and unclean animals, and holiness in general?
- 5. In a way, the topic of parsha Vayikra is death. Why is it that we should be reading about dying as we are beginning a whole new cycle of salvation in the month of Nissan? Bonus: incorporate the idea of "unleavened bread" in your answer.
- 6. What can we do practically to work on controlling our speech this month?
