11:2-16

1 Corinthians 11:2

Now I commend you because you remember me in everything and maintain the **traditions** $(\pi\alpha\rho\alpha\delta\sigma\sigma\iota\varsigma)$ even as I delivered them to you.



1 Corinthians 11:16

If anyone is inclined to be contentious, we have no such **custom** ($\sigma \nu \nu \eta \theta \epsilon \iota \alpha$), nor do the assemblies of God.


2 Thessalonians 2:15

"But you have a **custom** that I should release one man for you at the Passover. So do you want me to release to you the King of the Jews?"


The Problem:

NOTES:

Exodus 28:4,40 These are the garments that they shall make: a breastpiece, an ephod, a robe, a coat of checker work, a <u>turban</u>, and a sash. They shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother and his sons to serve me as priests.... For Aaron's sons you shall make coats and sashes and <u>caps</u>. You shall make them for glory and beauty.

2 Samuel 15:30 But David went up the ascent of the Mount of Olives, weeping as he went, barefoot and with his head covered. And all the people who were with him covered their heads, and they went up, weeping as they went.

Romans 12:6-8 Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them:

- if prophecy, in proportion to our faith;
- if service, in our serving;
- the one who **teaches**, in his teaching;
- the one who exhorts, in his exhortation;
- the one who **imparts**, in generosity;
- the one who **leads**, with zeal;
- the one who does acts of **mercy**, with cheerfulness.

Ephesians 4:11-14 And he gave the <u>apostles</u>, the <u>prophets</u>, the <u>evangelists</u>, the <u>shepherd - teachers</u>, to equip the called-out ones for the work of service, for building up the body of Messiah, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Messiah, so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes.
