 - Cared for the sick
 - Devoted to every good work

The Partial Widow

• Has children / family who can help

The Self-indulgent Widow

- Pursues her own pleasures
- Is 'dead' while she lives

The Young Widow

- May tend to idleness, therefore...
- Should remarry
