1 Timothy 6:14

...that you keep the commandment without stain or reproach until the **appearing** of our Master – King Yeshua...

2 Timothy 4:8

In the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.

2 Timothy 4:2

Herald the Word. Be ready in season *and* out of season. **Reprove**, **rebuke**, **exhort** ...

1) Reprove (ελεγχω) – (c. 3:16)"to expose"

"If your brother sins, go and **show him his fault** in private. If he listens to you, you have won your brother."

(Matt. 18:15)

2) Rebuke (επιτιμαω)

"to strictly appraise someone" or "assess a penalty"

And He was stating the matter plainly. And Peter took Him aside and began to **rebuke** Him. But turning around and seeing His disciples, He **rebuked** Peter and said, "Get behind Me, Satan, for you are not setting your mind on God's interests, but man's." (Mk. 8:32-33)

3) Exhort (παρακαλεω)

"to call to one's side"

"Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted." (Matt. 5:4)

And with many other words [Peter] solemnly testified and kept on **exhorting** them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation!"

(Acts 2:40)
