


James 3:13-15


6 Kinds of Change:



Genesis 35:2 So Jacob said to his household and to all who were with him, "Put away the foreign gods which are among you, and purify yourselves, and **change** your garments."

Genesis 45:22 To each of them he gave changes of garments, but to Benjamin he gave three hundred *pieces of* silver and five changes of garments.

Isaiah 2:18 But the idols will completely vanish.



NOTES:

James 3:13-15 Who among you is wise and understanding? Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom. But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and *so* lie against the truth. This wisdom is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly, soulish, demonic.

Philippians 1:15-18 Some, to be sure, are preaching Messiah even from envy and strife, but some also from good will. The latter *do it* out of love, knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the gospel. The former proclaim Messiah out of selfish ambition rather than from pure motives, thinking to cause me distress in my imprisonment. What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Messiah is proclaimed, and in this I rejoice.

1 Timothy 6:5 ...and constant friction between men of depraved mind and deprived of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means of gain.
