Now it came about that when **Sanballat** heard that we were rebuilding the wall, he became furious and very angry and mocked the Jews... Now **Tobiah** the Ammonite *was* near him and he said, "Even what they are building – if a fox should jump on *it*, he would break their stone wall down!"
