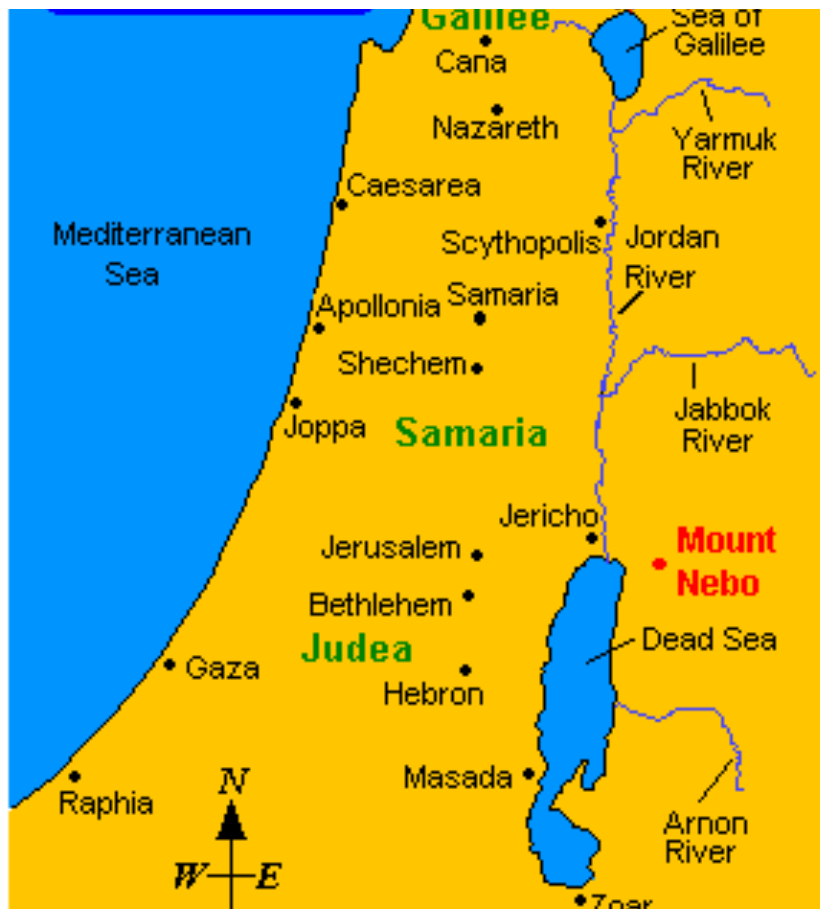

Deuteronomy 34:1

Then Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, to the top of Pisgah, which is opposite Jericho. And the LORD showed him all the land.





Dt 34:5

So Moses the servant of the LORD
died there in the land of Moab...

Dt 34:4

“...I have let you see it with your eyes, but you shall not go over there.”

Spiritual Leadership Principles

1. Have a Correct (Bigger) Vision

What do I want for my children?

Matthew 5:3-12

Blessed are the poor in spirit...

Blessed are those who mourn...

Blessed are the meek...

Blessed are those who hunger and
thirst for righteousness...

Blessed are the merciful...

Blessed are the pure in heart...

Blessed are the peacemakers...

Blessed are those who are
persecuted for righteousness sake...

2. Love their mother well.

Isaiah 54:5

For your Maker is your husband, the
LORD of hosts is His Name

Ephesian 5: 1, 25

Therefore, be imitators of God..

Husbands, love your wives, as Christ
loved the Church and gave himself up
for her.

3. Remember, they're always watching.

Matthew 5:16

...let your light shine before others, so
that they may see your good works
and give glory to your Father who is
in heaven.



4. Teach in every situation.

Deuteronomy 6-9

And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart.

You shall **teach them diligently** to your children, and shall talk of them when you **sit** in your house, and when you **walk** by the way, and when you **lie** down, and when you **rise**.

5. Find your adventure in the things of God, not the world.

Matthew 6:33

But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

6. Don't forget to lead. Remember!

Isaiah 58:13-14

If you turn back your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on my holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight and the holy day of the LORD honorable; if you honor it, not going your own ways, or seeking your own pleasure, or talking idly; then you shall take delight in the LORD, and I will make you ride on the heights of the earth...

7. Just do it!

Philippians 3:12

Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, **but I press on** to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own.

Emunah (Faith)

Bitachon (Trust)

“Bitachon (trust) in God, is not simply a higher form of emunah (faith).

Bitachon is a whole different way of relating to God. If one is faced with a problem and one has emunah, then one has faith that God will help him overcome his problems. But if one has bitachon, one doesn't think there is a problem at all, for he understands that God doesn't send problems, only challenges.”
