

Question #3:

*“What is a prophet? What is prophesying? In **Numbers 11:27-29** Moses states that he would that God’s people were prophets. **1 Cor. 13:9** states that we prophecy in part [but that it will be done away with]. Then, in **1 Cor. 14:1** Paul desires that we all prophesy. There is indication that it’s relevant and important, however, I’m not certain what it is.” K.K.*

(A) Numbers 11:27-29

So a young man ran and told Moses and said, “Eldad and Medad are **prophesying** in the camp.” Then Joshua the son of Nun, the attendant of Moses from his youth, said, “Moses, my master, restrain them.” But Moses said to him, “Are you jealous for my sake? Would that all Adonai’s people were **prophets**, that Adonai would put His spirit upon them!”

(B) 1 Corinthians 13:8-13

Love never fails; but if there are gifts of **prophecy**, they will be done away; if there are tongues, they will cease; if there is knowledge, it will be done away. For we know in part and we **prophecy** in part; but when the perfect comes, the partial will be done away. When I was a child, I used to speak like a child, think like a child, reason like a child; when I became a man, I did away with childish things. For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face; now I know in part, but then I will know fully just as I also have been fully known. But now faith, hope, love, abide these three; but the greatest of these is love.

(C) 1 Corinthians 14:1

Pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may **prophecy**.

Genesis 20:7

“Now therefore, restore the man’s wife, for he [Abraham] is a **prophet**, and he will pray for you and you will live ...”

3 - The Personality of a Prophet

Romans 12:6-8 Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly: if ^①**prophecy**, according to the proportion of his faith; if ^②service, in his serving; or he who ^③teaches, in his teaching; or he who ^④exhorts, in his exhortation; he who ^⑤gives, with liberality; he who ^⑥leads, with diligence; he who ^⑦shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

... lay aside the old self, which corrupts itself in accordance to the deceitful lusts, and that you be renewed in the **spirit of your mind**, and put on the new self, which according to God is created in truthful righteousness and holiness.
