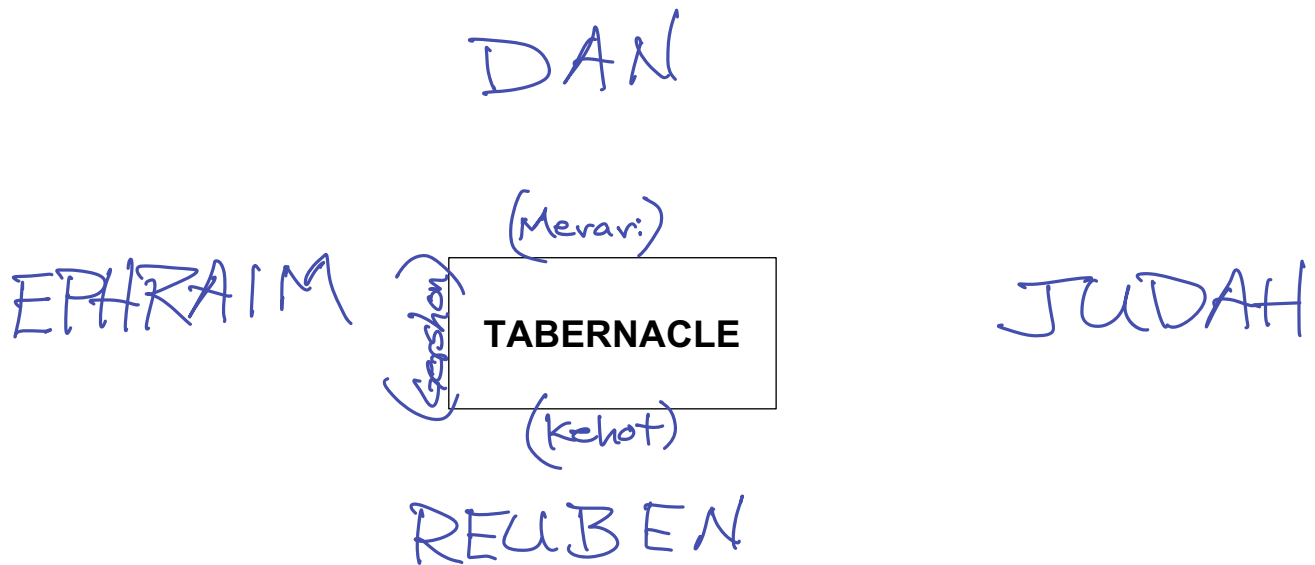

**Hebrews 13:13** Therefore let us go to Him outside the camp and bear the reproach He endured.

**Luke 22:41-42** And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, saying, "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from Me. Nevertheless, not My will, but Yours, be done."

**Song of Solomon 3:7-8** Behold, it is the litter of Solomon! Around it are sixty mighty men, some of the mighty men of Israel, all of them wearing swords and expert in war, each with his sword at his thigh, against terror by night.

**2 Samuel 6:6-8** And when they came to the threshing floor of Nacon, Uzzah put out his hand to the ark of God and took hold of it, for the oxen stumbled. And David was angry because Adonai had broken out against Uzzah. And that place is called Perez-Uzzah to this day.
