

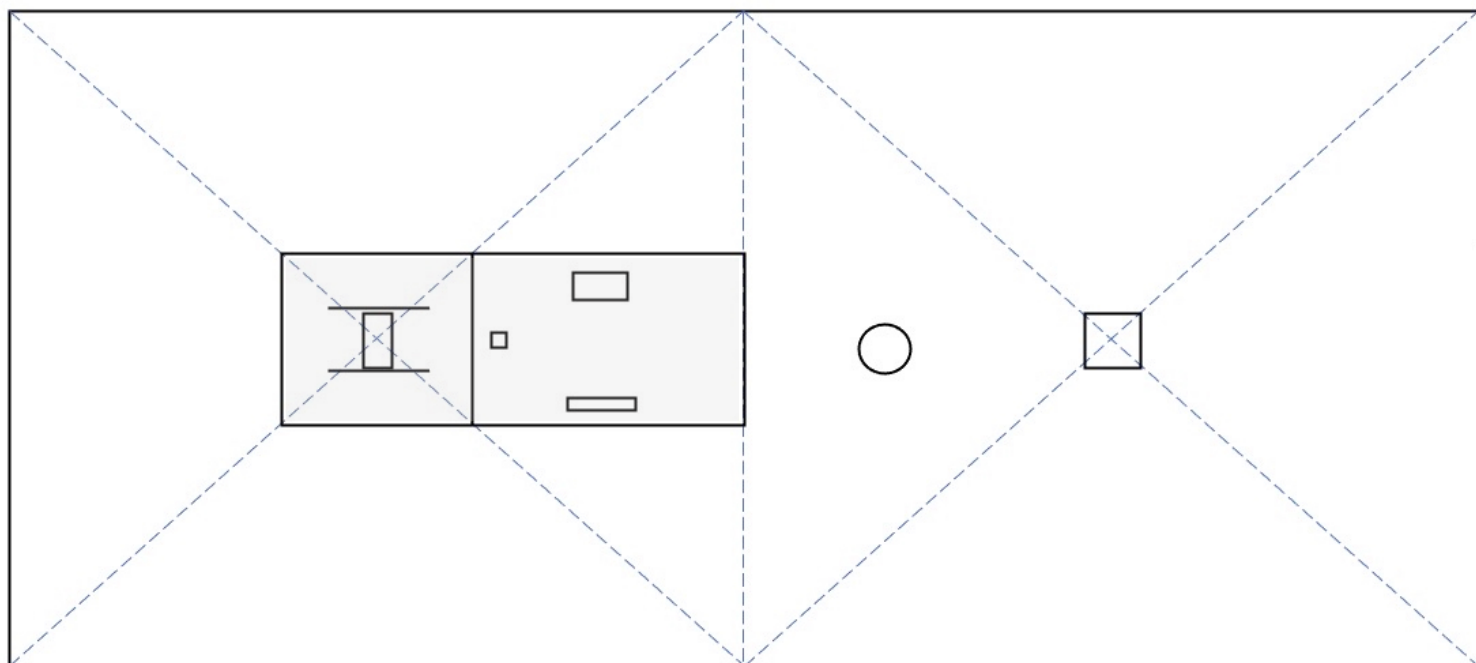
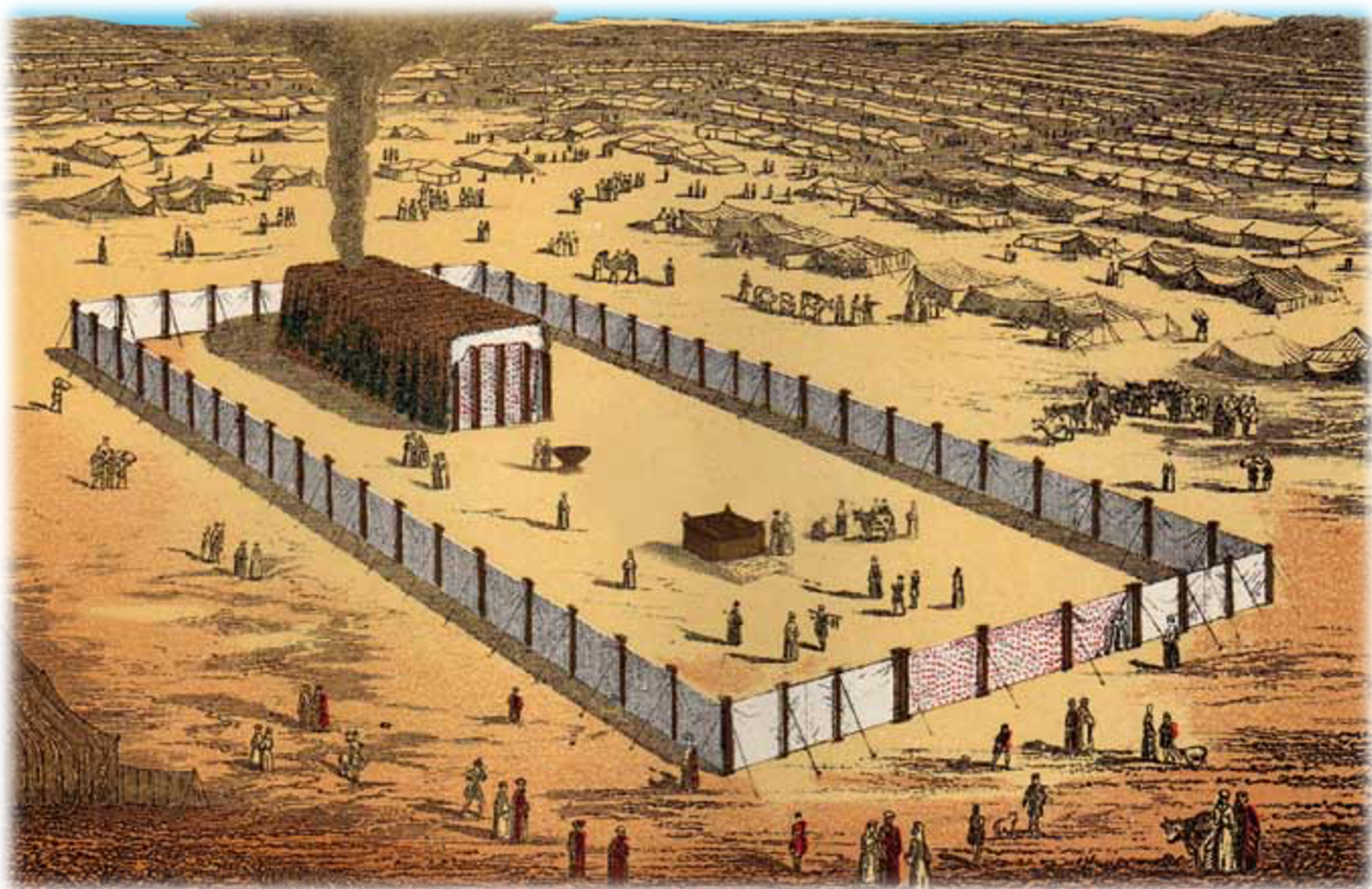

(Exodus 25-30:10)

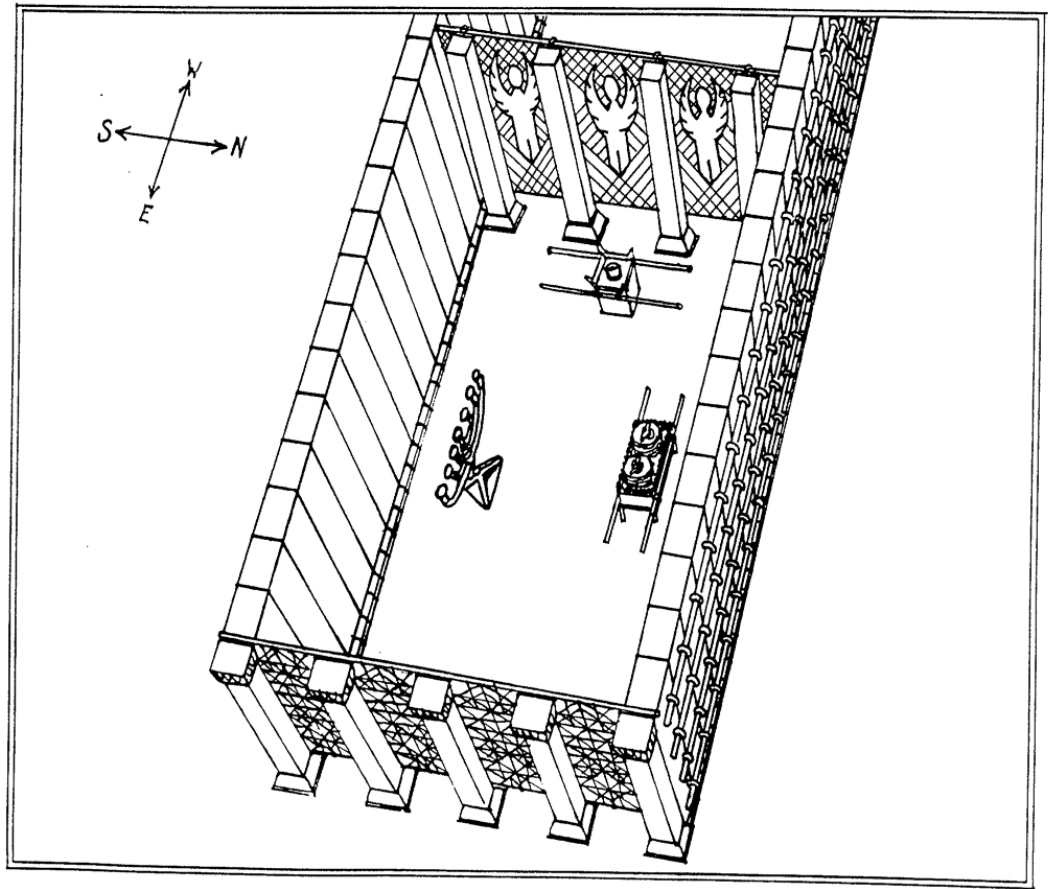

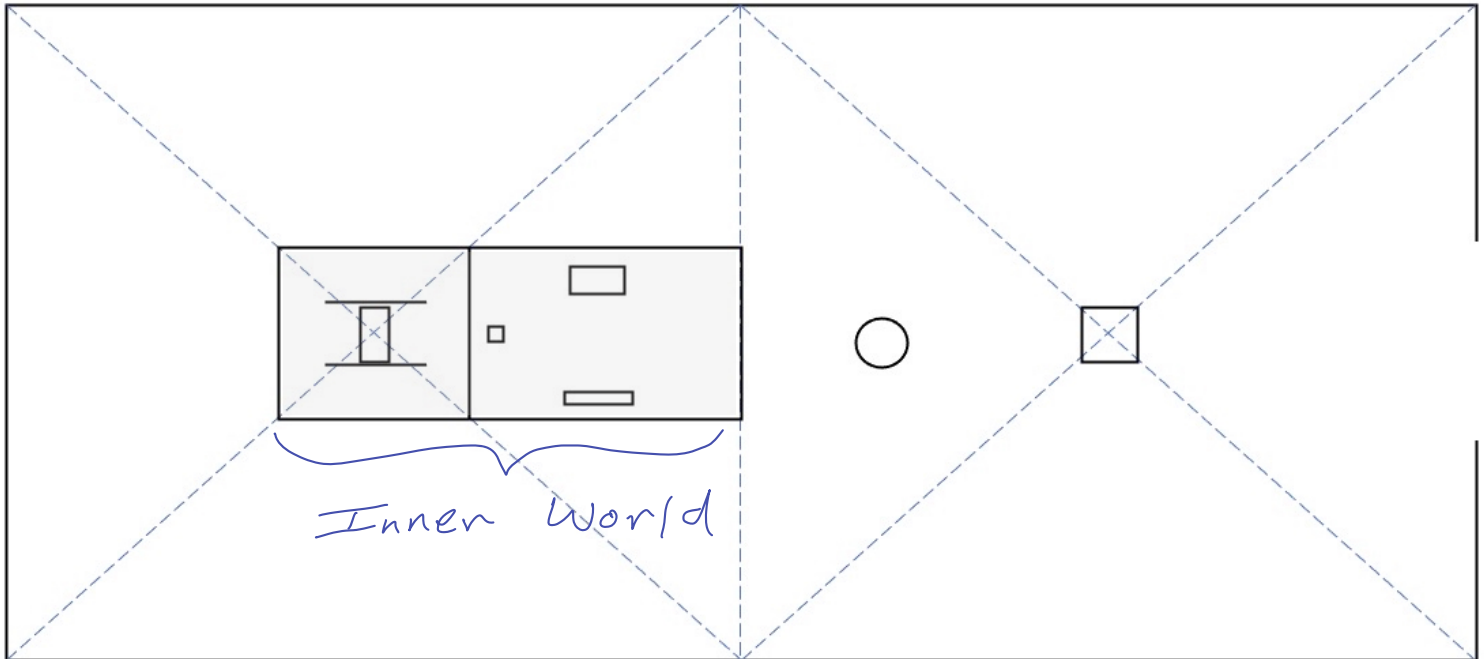

1 Thessalonians 5:23 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Master Yeshua the Messiah.

Moses said before the Holy One, blessed is He, "But they are destined one day, due to their recurring rebelliousness, to have neither Tabernacle nor Temple, and what will become of them then?! The Holy One, blessed is He, replied, "I will take from them a righteous man and make him collateral for them, and with this I will grant atonement to them for all their sins." – Midrash Rabbah (Shemot) 35.4

Exodus 25:20 The cherubim shall spread out their wings above, overshadowing the arc cover with their wings, their faces one to another. Toward the arc cover shall the faces of the cherubim be.

Numbers 7:89 And when Moses went into the tent of meeting to speak with Adonai, he heard the voice speaking to him from above the over that was on the ark of the testimony, from between the two cherubim, and it spoke to him.

A human being who becomes sanctified ... even his simple physical acts become actual articles of sanctity ... and it is as if he walks with God in the Land of Life while he still lives his life in this world. Such an individual is himself tantamount to a Mishkan, a Temple, and an altar. (Moshe Chaim Luzzatto – Mesilat Yesharim, Ch.26)
