

The Tamid Offerings:

Exodus 29:38-42

Now this is what you shall offer on the altar: two lambs a year-old, day by day **continually**. One lamb you shall offer in the morning, and the other lamb you shall offer at twilight. And with the first lamb a tenth measure of fine flour mingled with a fourth of a *hin* of beaten oil, and a fourth of a *hin* of wine for a drink offering. The other lamb you shall offer at twilight and shall offer with it a grain offering and its drink offering, as in the morning, for a pleasing aroma, a food offering to Adonai. It shall be a **continual** burnt offering throughout your generations at the entrance of the tent of meeting before Adonai, where I will meet with you, to speak to you there.

Discussion Questions:

- Review and discuss the importance of God hiding Himself. Why does He do this?
- Leviticus 6:3-4 describes the removal of the ashes to "a pure place". In Temple times, this pure place was the Mount of Olives. What events occurred on the Mount of Olives and how do they tie in with the ashes from the altar?
- Read Leviticus 7:8. What does this have to do with you and me? (Hint: Romans 12:1-2)
- What do you make of the peculiar ritual described in 8:23-24? Is there a personal application? (Hint: Revelation 20:6)

NINTH HOUR:

Matthew 27:46, 50 And about the ninth hour Yeshua cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" ... And Yeshua cried out again with a loud voice and yielded up His spirit.
