The Tabernacle Described 7x:

- 1. When God commands Moses (ch. 25-28,30a)
- 2. When Bezalel & Oholiab are named (31:1-11)
- 3. When Moses requests *terumah* (35:4-21)
- 4. When the work is performed (ch. 36-38)
- 5. When all is brought to Moses (39:33-42)
- 6. When God commanded Moses to erect the Tabernacle (40:1-16)
- 7. When Moses erected the Tabernacle (40:17-33)

The GOD of Impossible Things:

- The 7th plague = **FIRE & ICE** (Ex. 9:13-27)
- Revelation 1:14-15 ... His eyes were like a FLAME OF FIRE, his feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace, and his voice was like the roar of many WATERS.
- A glassy SEA mixed with FIRE (Rev. 15:2)
- "I immerse you with WATER ... He will immerse you with the holy spirit and with FIRE." (Matt. 3:11)
- "If your enemy is thirsty, give him **WATER** to drink, for you will heap **BURNING COALS** on his head..."
- Daniel 7:9-10 "As I looked, thrones were placed, and the Ancient of Days took his seat... A STREAM OF FIRE issued and came out from before him...
- Revelation 22:1 Then the angel showed me the RIVER OF THE WATER OF LIFE, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb
- Destruction by **WATER** vs. destruction by **FIRE**




The Torah was given in the presence of three things – Fire, Water, and Wilderness.


B'Midbar Rabbah 1.7

Numbers 31:22-23

"...only the gold, the silver, the bronze, the iron, the tin, and the lead, everything that can stand the fire, you shall pass through the **FIRE**, and it shall be clean. Nevertheless, it shall also be purified with the **WATER** for impurity. And whatever cannot stand the **FIRE**, you shall pass through the **WATER**."





Discussion Questions:

- Try to think of other occasions where we find fire and water together in the Scriptures.
- Think about the cleansing work God has done in your own life. How has He cleansed you spiritually?
- Discuss Hebrews 6:19-20. Compare a physical anchor with the spiritual anchor of the soul.
- Discuss how God's Word can be used for life; and how it can be used to do harm.

NOTES:

Proverbs 25:2 It is the glory of God to conceal things, but the glory of kings is to search things out.

Ezekiel 16:10 I clothed you also with embroidered cloth and shod you with <u>tachash</u> [תחש]. I wrapped you in fine linen and covered you with silk.

Genesis 2:7 Then Adonai Elohim formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the <u>breath</u> [נשמה] *neshamah*] of life, and the man became a living <u>soul</u> [נשמה] *nephesh*].

Ezekiel 7:11 Violence has grown up into a rod of wickedness. None of them shall remain, nor their abundance, nor their wealth; neither shall there be <u>preeminence</u> [, *noah*] among them.

Isaiah 6:6-7 Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with **tongs** from the altar. And he touched my mouth and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for."

Psalm 24:3-4 Who shall ascend the hill of Adonai? And who shall stand in His holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to what is false and does not swear deceitfully.

Genesis 19:1 The two angels came to Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw them, he rose to meet them and bowed himself with his <u>face</u> [אפים, *apa'im*] to the earth

Exodus 15:11 "Who is like You, Adonai, among the gods? Who is like You, majestic in holiness, <u>awesome</u> (נורא, *nora*] in glorious deeds, doing wonders?"

Exodus 39:30 They made the plate of the holy <u>crown</u> [נזר], *nezer*] of pure gold, and wrote on it an inscription, like the engraving of a signet, "Holy to Adonai."

"If the one who receives it is deserving, then the Torah becomes a life-giving medicine. If however the person is not deserving, then it becomes a poison [literally: "a drug of death"]. (R' Yehoshua ben Levi)
