John 8:56-58

“Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad.” So the Judeans said to Him, “You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?” Yeshua said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am.”

Defining Terms:

1) Grace

(χαρις / חן) = “favor”
charis chen

FAVOR

(Whether deserved or undeserved)

2) Gospel / Preach

(εὐαγγέλιον / בשרה) = (n.) “good news”
euangelion *basarah*

(εὐαγγελίζω / בשר) = (v.) “proclaim good news”
euangelizo *basar*

GOOD NEWS / PROCLAIM

3) Faith / Belief

(πίστις / אמונה) = (n.) “faithfulness”
pistis *emunah*

FAITHFULNESS

(πίστευω / אמן) = (v.) “have faith”/“believe”
pisteuo *amen*

(πίστος / נאמן) = (adj.) “faithful”
pistos *ne'amon*

James 2:17-20

Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, being by itself. But someone may well say, “You have faith and I have works. Show me your faith without the works, and I will show you my faith by my works.” You have faith that God is one? You do well. Even the demons have that faith, and they tremble. But are you willing to recognize, O foolish fellow, that faith without works is useless?
