Rosh Hashanah 2020

Leviticus 23:23-24

Again Adonai spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, 'In the seventh month on the first of the month you shall have a rest, a reminder by *teruah*, a holy convocation."

Exodus 34:22

You shall celebrate the Feast of Shavuot, that is, the first fruits of the wheat harvest; and the Feast of Ingathering at the turn of the year.

Numbers 29:1

Now in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall also have a holy convocation; you shall do no laborious work. It will be to you a **yom teruah**.


Three Rosh Hashanah Traditions:

קרן (*keren*) "horn"

Exodus 34:29-30,35

When Mose came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand, he didn't realize that the skin of his face **radiated** as a result of his talking with Him. When Aharon and the people of Isra'el saw Moshe, and behold his face **radiated** and they were afraid to approach him...The sons of Israel would see the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face **radiated**. So Moses would replace the veil over his face until he went in to speak with Him.

Shemoneh Esrei (15th Blessing):

Her priests also I will clothe with **salvation**, and her godly ones will sing aloud for joy. There I will cause the *horn* of David to spring forth; I have prepared a lamp for My **mashiach**.

Ephesians 5:13-14

But all things become visible when they are exposed by the light, for everything that becomes visible is light. For this reason, it says...

"Awake, sleeper, and arise from the dead, And Messiah will shine upon you."

Romans 13:11-14

And this *do*, knowing the time, that it is already the hour for you to awaken from sleep; for now salvation is nearer to us than when we believed. The night is almost gone, and the day is at hand.
