





The Commandment:

#1 - Moses, Israel After the Plagues

WAR: Exodus ch. 7-12 Sukkot: Exodus 12:35-37

Exodus 12:37

Now the sons of Israel journeyed from Rameses to **Sukkot**, about six hundred thousand men on foot, aside from children.

Beware the "False Sukkot"

Genesis 33:17

Jacob journeyed to **Sukkot**, and built for himself a house and made **sukkot** for his livestock. Therefore the place is named **Sukkot**.

Hebrews 12:2

fixing our eyes on Yeshua, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the **joy** set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and

has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Hebrews 13:12-13

Therefore Yeshua also, that He might sanctify the people through His own blood, suffered outside the gate. **So, let us go out to Him outside the camp, bearing His reproach.** For here we do not have a lasting city, but we are seeking the city which is to come.
